

How to measure for girth length

Divide horse from top of wither (A) to sternum (B) in half to get C.

Divide CB in half again to get D.

Girth buckles must sit between C and D, safe place is to go for half way between C and D (X).

Measure from X to B (make sure you are in the centre of the horse's chest at B) multiply XB measurement by 2, that will be the length of the girth to order.

If you have more than one horse choose a girth length that is never on or below D and never on or above C on all of them, or order more than one girth.
